




PROCEDURE

A. Electric Heater Installation


- Electric heater will be installed in unit from above with wiring connection made from below. Installing the electric heater can be done prior to placing unit on the roof.
- AWARNING ELECTRICAL SHOCK HAZARD.
 Disconnect 120 Vac power from RV. Failure to obey this warning could result in death or serious injury.
 - **NOTICE** Disconnect the positive (+) 12 Vdc terminal from supply battery. Otherwise, damage to unit could occur.
- 2. Remove outside plastic shroud. See (FIG. 1).



3. Remove evaporator cover. Grasp with both hands and lift cover to remove. See (FIG. 2).



- 4. Remove electric heater from carton.
- 5. Install electric heater.
 - a. Place electric heater cable down through return air opening. See (FIG. 3).





b. **NOTICE** Do **NOT** pinch wiring or allow wiring to rub against sharp edges. If wiring is damaged, it **MUST** be replaced by a qualified service technician.

Route 120 Vac electrical cord in a manner that will not interfere with positioning the electric heater.


Be careful not to pinch or damage 120 Vac electrical cord. When in proper position the cord will pass through clearance cutout in heater shield.

c. Place electric heater in position and install four (4) supplied 10-24 x .38 HHW screws (two each side). See (FIG. 4). Use of longer screw could damage the evaporator coil.



- 6. Reinstall evaporator cover and outside plastic shroud.
- 7. Install unit per installation instructions provided with unit.

a. Plug the 3 pin electrical cord from heater into the mating connector in the electronic control box . See (FIG. 5). To be done prior to installing the ceiling template.



- 8. **AWARNING** FIRE HAZARD. Do **NOT** allow wiring or other objects to contact electric heater. Failure to obey this warning could result in death or serious injury.
 - Secure all wiring in a manner that will prevent them from coming in contact with electric heater.
- System checkout Refer to the unit operating instructions and verify that all features of the installed system work.
