Use and Care

1. Pre-cool your Avalanche Cooler

Use ice to chill your cooler a minimum of 4 hours or overnight for best performance. Avoid direct sunlight when preparing your cooler.

2. Pre-cool contents

When possible, chill or freeze your goods prior to packing them into your Avalanche cooler. The ice won't have to work as hard to get the contents cold and it will last longer.

3. Keep the cold water

As ice melts, cold water takes its place. Don't empty the cold water – it's almost as cold as the remaining ice, and works as an insulator. More water inside, means less space for cold robbing air to get in. Keep in mind that frequently opening the lid reduces the ice retention and melts the ice faster. Try to open the lid as little as possible. Close and latch the lid after accessing contents.

- Fill your Avalanche cooler with ice as much as possible. Ideally 2 times the amount being stored is recommended. More ice means less air, means longer ice retention.
- Block ice melts at a slower rate than small cubes of ice, so it maintains cold longer. However, cubed ice will chill the cooler faster. Benefits of both sizes of ice should be considered for optimum cooling and retention. Dry ice will quickly freeze/burn exposed skin. Always handle dry ice with gloves and allow adequate ventilation. Adding a small amount of dry ice will improve the retention of cubed ice.

Cleaning

Keeping your Avalanche cooler clean is important. Before and after each use, clean with dish soap and water. For more stubborn stains, use a mixture of water and bleach (6 parts water to 1 part bleach) and use a soft brush. To clean the threads of the drain plug and lid seal, use a soft toothbrush. Always dry inside and out before storing.

AWARNING

SUFFOCATION AND CHILD ENTRAPMENT HAZARD. It is possible for small children to be trapped inside cooler. Adult supervision is required when cooler is in use around small children. Keep cooler out of children's reach when NOT in use. Failure to obey this warning could result in death or brain damage.



This warranty will be in effect for seven years from the date of purchase by Original Purchaser. It is suggested that the original purchaser retain a copy of the dated bill of sale as evidence of the date of purchase.
