

Section VI—Health Hazard Data**EMERGENCY OVERVIEW****HEALTH HAZARDS:**

Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Avoid breathing dust. Ingestion may cause vomiting, diarrhea.

Route(s) of Entry:

INHALATION:

Remove person to fresh air.

SKIN CONTACT:

Remove contaminated clothing. Wash clothes before reuse. Wash affected skin area thoroughly with soap and water for at least 5 minutes. Seek medical attention if irritation occurs.

EYE CONTACT:

Rinse immediately with water. Remove contact lenses. Flush with copious amounts of water for at least 15 minutes. Seek medical attention.

INGESTION:

If swallowed call a physician or poison control center immediately. Do not administer anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

CARCINOGENICITY:

None known

Signs and Symptoms of Exposure

May cause slight eye irritation. May act as foreign body in eye. Ingestion may cause vomiting, diarrhea.

Medical Conditions Generally Aggravated by Exposure

None known.

Emergency and First Aid Procedures

Seek medical assistance for further treatment, observation and support if necessary.

Steps to Be Taken in Case Material Is Released or Spilled

Respiratory Protection (*Specify Type*)

Eye Protection

Close fitting chemical safety goggles with face shield and safety glasses.

Other Protective Clothing or Equipment

Nitrile rubber or similar impervious apron, eye wash station, safety shower.

Work/Hygienic Practices

Avoid unnecessary contact. Wear proper protective clothing and equipment. Avoid breathing vapors. Do not allow material to come in contact with skin or eyes. Wash thoroughly after handling especially before eating, drinking or smoking.
